## <u>Rules</u>

- All tests are Cadora Inc. <u>http://www.cadora.ca/dressage-tests/</u>
- Only tests A, B, or C can be used
- All videos must be sent as a link on the entry form using YouTube (instructions are available on our website for those who need them)
- All videos must be taken from C
- Landscape orientation is required
- Videos can zoom and follow the rider, however, when zooming to far end, F and K (corners) must be visible in frame.
- Horse and rider must be visible at all times in the video. Be prepared for a low score for that movement if not visible. Please proof your video.
- Test callers are allowed and recommended
- Use of a 20 x 60 ring is preferred but 20 x 40 is accepted. Please specify ring size on entry. Classes may be divided accordingly.
- All rings must have letters or markers in place of the letters
- EC rules must be followed as much as possible. The rules can be found at <u>https://www.equestrian.ca/programs-services/rules</u>.
- Please dress professionally with clinic or show attire.
- The person taking the video must announce the rider, test, and date.
- Tests must be recorded between the closing date of the previous show and the closing date of the current show.
- Readers or callers must stand at E or B if room permits, otherwise must still be somewhere they can be seen on camera
- AA/Open/Jr. classes may be combined if low numbers
- Maximum number of tests per horse/rider combination is 3
- Put videos on entry in preferred order in case we have to limit the number allowed per rider
- If the show is over subscribed and another judge cannot be found on short notice, we will limit the number of tests judged per rider/horse combination. Members will get priority.
- Riders must live in Ontario to be eligible.

**<u>Prizes</u>** will be awarded to 3rd place in all classes. No prizes will be awarded for scores less than 50%. If there is only one entry in a class, the following percentages apply to determine the placing:

 $1^{st}$  place = 63% or higher

2<sup>nd</sup> place - 60% to 62.9.9%

3<sup>rd</sup> place - 57% to 59.9%;

All prizes for will be available at our first live show on May 11, 2025.
